Mandated test for Traditional classes grades 6 ~ 10.

This is a 1 hour test, which consist of 85 multiple choice questions. This three part tests consist of listening comprehension (20 minutes), grammar, and reading comprehension (40 minutes). For any questions answered incorrectly, points will be deducted.
