Exam time is 1 hour. Exam is divided into 3 parts: Listening (20minutes), Grammar and Reading (40minutes). There is a total of 85 questions. Listening part of the test uses CD. Exam contents include food, clothing, shelter, transportation, entertainment and everyday words and phrases.
