 - Chinese input method: Should be properly configured, such as Pinyin or Zhuyin input. The characters must be set to Traditional characters.
 - The laptop should have a **USB port** available to use for flash drive. The school will provide a flash drive to download students' typed
 - o Power cord and (or) mouse. Please also bring your extension cord in case it is needed.
